Dr Fergus Scott MBBS, FRANZCOG, DDU, CMFM, COGU, MBA

Dr Fergus Scott is a graduate of Monash University and specialised in Obstetrics and Gynaecology. Subspecialisation was in both maternal fetal medicine and Obstetrics and Gynaecology ultrasound. He became a partner in Sydney Ultrasound for Women in 1996 and is a staff specialist in the Imaging Department at the Royal Hospital for Women. Fergus has been on the medical council of the World Federation of Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology representing ASUM, the subspecialty committee for Obstetric and Gynaecological Ultrasound for the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists. He is a past President of ASUM and is currently an examiner for COGU. His areas of interest include invasive testing in pregnancy, 3/4D imaging and first trimester screening including non-invasive prenatal testing (NIPT).

Dr Anjana Thottungal MBBS, MD, FRCOG (UK) FRANZCOG, DDU

Dr. Anjana Thottungal is an accomplished Consultant Sonologist from Perth. She completed her training as an Obstetrician and Gynaecologist in the U.K and is a Fellow of RCOG, London. Anjana obtained RCOG/RCR Diploma in advanced Obstetrics ultrasound, MSc in Obstetrics and Gynaecology ultrasound and special skills training in maternal medicine. After migrating in 2007 to Australia she obtained a DDU and Fellowship of RANZCOG after her training in Obstetrics and Gynaecology ultrasound in King Edward Memorial Hospital (KEMH). Anjana is the Director of Perth O&G Ultrasound practice (POGU), which she set up in 2012. She was the first Sonologist to establish sonovaginography and specialist scan service for severe endometriosis in WA in 2012. She is the founder Chair of the multidisciplinary endometriosis focus group that meets regularly at KEMH. Anjana has an interest in education and training and has lectured extensively on her favourite topic of deep infiltrating endometriosis.

Dr Glen Lo MBBS, BMedSc (Hons) FRANZCR

Dr Glen Lo is a graduate of the University of Western Australia and WA Inter-Hospital Training program in Diagnostic Radiology. He undertook subspecialty fellowship training in both Women's and Abdominal Imaging at the University of Toronto, and currently works in both private (Western Ultrasound for Women) and public (Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital) sectors. Glen has been a Full Instructor in Advanced Life Support for the Australian Resuscitation Council. He has presented both poster and oral presentations at multiple national and international conferences. During his fellowship training in Canada, Glen was awarded the Roberta Jong Award for his original research project, and has also received multiple grants in Australia for research projects as an undergraduate.
